

- Provides independent advice and capacity building support to <u>beneficiary countries</u> to help prepare and assess high quality projects to be co-financed by <u>EU Structural and Cohesion</u> <u>Funds</u> (including <u>Just Transition Fund</u>), by the <u>Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance (IPA)</u> and by the <u>Connecting Europe Facility (CEF)</u>.


