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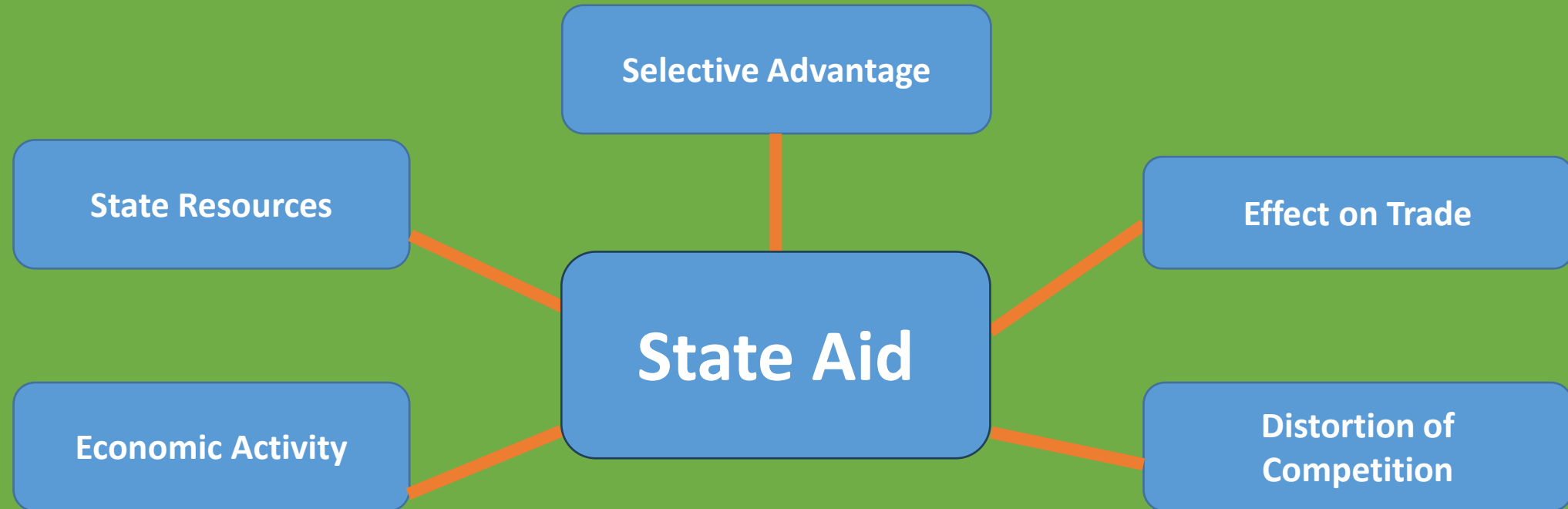

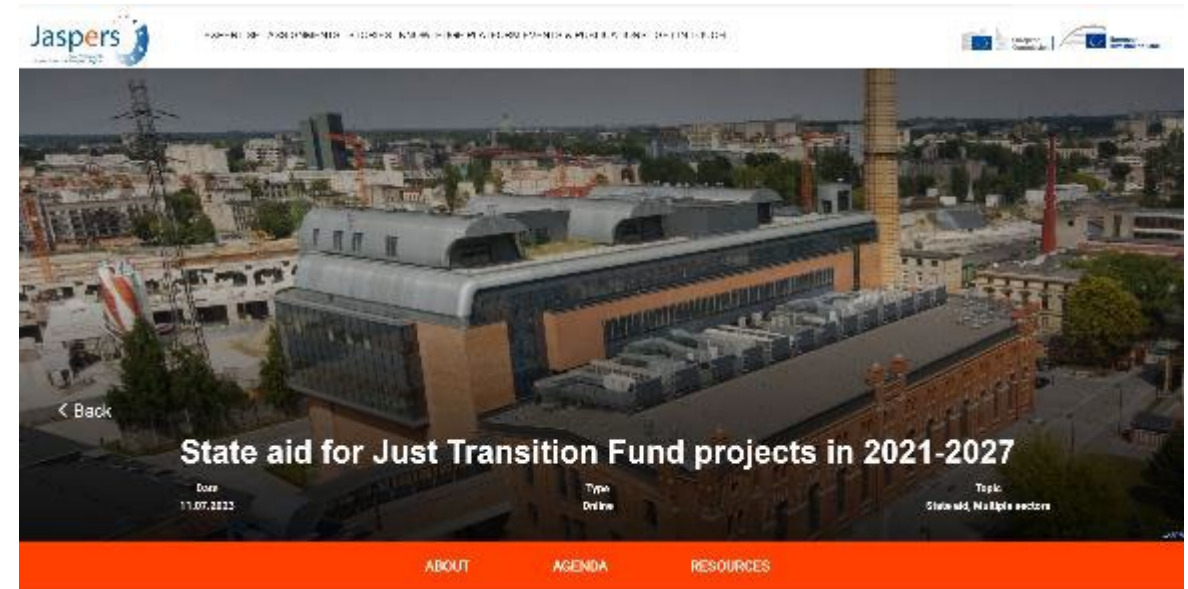
What makes State aid rules important for JTF?

State Aid Issues Identified

1. Combination of aid from JTF with centrally managed EU funds
2. Splitting of JTF integrated projects under different State aid objectives in line with GBER Art. 4
3. Aid to productive investments implemented by large undertakings (Regional Aid vs TCTF)
4. Aid for land repurposing & Aid for land rehabilitation in brownfield sites
5. Rules for algae cultivation for bio-plastics production
6. Support to Renewable Energy Communities (State aid vs No-aid concept)
7. Applying the concept of ancillary economic activity in Energy Efficiency projects
8. Decarbonisation projects: How to treat production increase higher than 2%
9. For individual notifications of projects that might be supported by countries outside the EU how to demonstrate access to a subsidy from a third country?

Recommendations

JASPERS support

Apply GBER and de minimis rules

Use State aid schemes (check for existing ones for other funds)

Check RRF Guidance templates (RES, Energy Efficiency, DH)

Use Temporary Crisis and Transition Framework – where applicable

Check DG REGIO- COMP trainings on State aid, Community of practitioners on State aid

Close collaboration with national / regional State aid authorities

Check replies of DG COMP to wiki questions

Structure clear State aid questions

Initiate prenotification contacts with DG COMP
