#### **Description of the Webinar**

This webinar is part of a series of trainings on the Habitats Directive and project preparation. The first training was delivered with the format of a workshop in [December 2019](#) and the second training as webinar held in [June 2020](#). The webinar is organised in cooperation with DG REGIO and DG ENVIRONMENT whose representatives will make key contributions.

The purpose of this webinar is to raise awareness around key requirements of Article 6(3) of the Habitats Directive 92/43/EEC in the context of Major Projects preparation with a particular focus on the importance of Site-specific conservation objectives (SSCO) and topics such as: setting up of SSCO, undertaking Appropriate Assessment (AA) in view of the SSCO and last but not least the necessary completeness of the Major Project, Appendix 1 Declaration (aka Natura 2000 Declaration).

Speakers will address challenges frequently encountered in project preparation and will recommend possible ways forward. As this is the second in line planned webinar, with similar content as the one already held in June 2020, the target audience are staff from Managing Authorities, Environmental Authorities and project promoters that did not attend the first one.

The webinar will be held in English and participants will have the chance to join the Q&A discussions.

For the effective participation to this webinar, participants should have a basic knowledge of the main requirements of the Habitats Directive vis a vis projects (some recommended reading can be found at the end of this invitation).
