












### How do we engage on bus fleet projects?



- City/ public transport authority contacts JASPERS about a potential assignment at: <u>https://jaspers.eib.org/get-in-touch/index.htm</u> or via one of our offices
- Scope of cooperation is agreed in an Assignment Fiche and confirmed with national authorities and EC
- For JASPERS to get involved, there must be a link to EU funding eg. via ESIF or REACT-EU
- JASPERS support is free to beneficiaries and funded by the European Union and the EIB
- Support is provided through partnership and cooperation no need to go through a tender process.
- JASPERS experts provide hands-on direct advice, and help to mobilise additional experts if needed
- JASPERS comprises international experts; where needed it uses interpretation, translation facilities for documents, and local consultants to support working in local languages.
- JASPERS is managed by EIB, but there is no obligation to borrow from EIB (nor for EIB to lend)
- A mix of over 110 engineers, economists, environmental specialists and sector experts spread across 6 offices
